Ordered, That the Secretay issue Scrip to the property holders on Washington Street for the making and paving the gutter thereon, in

accordance with the Estimate of the City Engineer.

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The following orders were presented Read, and adopted.

Ordered, That the Street Commissioner erect two foot Bridges on New Jersey Street, and gravel a walk across Virginia Avenue, Also reconstruct the foot Bridges on Washington Street.

Ordered, That the Committee on the fire department put the Marion Engine and Hose in good repair, and the same be paid by the City Council.

Ordered, That the property holders on Washington Street on South side between Delaware and Alabama Streets grade and pave the same in accordance with the provisions of the ordinance on that subject.

Ordered, That the Secretary issue orders on the certificate of of the Committee on Streets and Alleys, on the work done on Kentucky Avenue.

The following Resolutions were presented, Read and adopted by the Council.

Resolved, That E. S. Alvord be authorised to make the side walk in front of his dwelling House, on Pennsylvania Street, in conformity with the present grade, and that the City Engineer set stakes for the same immediately.

Resolved, That the sum of forty dollars be appropriated towards erecting a foot Bridge across Pogues Run, on the South side of Washington Street.

Whereas, The said Rail Roads Companys have not complied with their agreement entered into with this City, in gravelling side walks, Streets and alleys and making the necessary crossings according to said agreement where said Roads crosses the several Streets in this City. Therefore Resolved, That the Marshall and Street Commissioner compel them to fulfil their agreement forthwith, and also compel them to remove the Water Station, and put the additions to the Delaware Street Bridge across Pogues Run.

Ordered, That the Secretary issue to Beck & Cofor Work done on Kentucky Avenue, the sum of \$150.00.

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The Committee to whom was referred the remonstrance of the property holders on New York Street between Noble and Alabama Streets against the grading and gravelling of said Street between the Streets aforesaid, made the following Report which was concurred in by the Council.
