G. O. 60, 1889—An ordinance amendatory and supplemental to the ordinance entitled "An ordinance authorizing the construction, extension and operation of certain passenger railways in and upon the streets of the City of Indianapolis;" ordained and established January 18th, 1864.


And it was passed by the following vote:
