

PROCEEDINGS OF BOARD OF ALDERMEN.

SPECIAL SESSION—MARCH 25, 1884.

The Board of Aldermen of the City of Indianapolis, met in the Aldermanic Chamber, Tuesday evening, March 25th, 1884, at half-past seven o'clock, in special session, pursuant to the following call:

To the Members of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Indianapolis:

Gentlemen:—You are hereby requested to meet in special session this evening, at 7:30 prompt, for the purpose of considering and passing G. O. 33, 1884, "An ordinance providing for the assessment of property in the City of Indianapolis upon which to base the tax levy for the year 1884," the consideration of said ordinance having been overlooked at the regular session held March 24, 1884.

The following entitled ordinance was read the second time, and then read the third time:

G. O. 33, 1884—An ordinance providing for the assessment of property in the City of Indianapolis, upon which to base the tax levy for the year 1884.
