

PROCEEDINGS OF JOINT CONVENTION.

THIRD SESSION—MAY 23, 1884.

The Common Council and Board of Aldermen of the City of Indianapolis, convened in the Council Chamber, Friday evening, May 23d, A. D. 1884, at eight o'clock, pursuant to the call of the President, as shown in Proceedings of the Common Council of May 20th, 1884. (See page 457, *ante*.)

George W. Spahr, President, called the Convention to order, and the following members were found to be present:

Aldermen Bernhamer and King—2; and Councilmen Benjamin, Coy, Dowling, Downe, Edenharter, Haugh, Rees, Reinecke, Sheppard, Spahr, and Wolf—11. Total Present, 13.

ABSENT—Aldermen Cobb, Cox, Endly, McHugh, Prier, Pritchard, Tallentire, and President Rorison—8 and Councilmen Cowie, Curry, Doyle, Gallahue, Mack, Moran, McClelland, Newcomb, Pearson, Reynolds, Smither, Thalman, Trusler, and Wharton—14. Total Absent, 22.

It appearing from the roll-call there was no quorum present, on motion by Councilman Coy, the Joint Convention adjourned, to meet again Wednesday evening, May 28th, 1884, at eight o'clock.
