INTRODUCTION OF APPROPRIATION ORDINANCES

By the City Controller:

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE No. 36, 1937

AN ORDINANCE appropriating to a certain designated fund in the Department of Finance budget the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000) from the unappropriated and unexpended anticipated 1937 balance of the general fund, and fixing a time when the same shall take effect.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDIANAPOLIS, INDIANA:

Section 1. That the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000) is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated and unexpended anticipated 1937 balance of the general fund to the Department of Finance and said sum is allocated in the following amounts to the following designated funds of the budget of said department:

Total	\$3,000.00


Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the mayor.

On motion of Mr. Oren, seconded by Mr. Wallace, the Common Council adjourned at 4:30 p. m.


