Tuesday June 6th 1854

The Council met at 8 o'clock P.M. Present all the Councilmen and the Present. The minutes of the preceeding meeting were corrected and approved.

Mr. Maguire moved That the Council proceed to the election of a Trustee for Common Schools. Which motion prevailed.

Mr. H.F. West was elected a Trustee of the Common Schools.

Mr. Karnes moved that the ordinances be taken from the table. Which motion prevailed.

Mr. Graydon presented an ordinance in reference to Lighting the Streets with gas at the expense of the property holders along the Streets where the Lamp posts are placed.

Mr. Pitts moved That the said ordinance be laid on the table. Which motion did not prevail.

Mr. Karns moved That said ordinance be referred to the City Attorney for his opinion thereon, to be reported at the next meeting of the Council. Which motion prevailed.

Mr. Graydon moved That the Civil Engineer be instructed to set grade stakes for a gutter and pavement on the South Side of Market Street between Pennsylvania and Circle Streets. Which motion prevailed.
