

PROCEEDINGS OF BOARD OF ALDERMEN

ADJOURNED SESSION—NOVEMBER 28, 1885.

The Board of Aldermen of the City of Indianapolis, met in the Aldermanic Chamber, Saturday evening, November 28th, A. D. 1885, at seven o'clock, in adjourned session.

PRESENT—Hon. Brainard Rorison, President of the Board of Aldermen, in the Chair, and Aldermen Cobb, Endly, Prier, Pritchard, and Tallentire—6.

ABSENT, 3—viz. Aldermen Bernhamer, King, and McHugh.

On motion by Alderman Prier, the following entitled ordinance was called up, and read the second and third times:

G. O. 42, 1885—An ordinance to amend certain sections of an ordinance entitled "An ordinance authorizing the City Clerk to appoint a Deputy to assist the Committees and Official Boards of the Common Council and Board of Aldermen in the better performance of their duties, prescribing the duties, and providing for the compensation of such Deputy, and repealing all ordinances in conflict therewith," ordained December 6, 1879, and to repeal Section four thereof.

And it was passed by the following vote:

AYES, 6—viz. Aldermen Cobb, Endly, Prier, Pritchard, Tallentire, and President Rorison.

NAYS—None.

Alderman Prier offered the following motion; which was adopted:

That C. Belmont be granted a special license for his Anatomical Museum, at the rate of twenty-five dollars per month; such license to be issued in the same manner as other like licenses are issued.

On motion, the Board of Aldermen then adjourned.
