

Common Council Chamber
March 22 1855

The Council met at 7 O'clock P M pursuant to call of the Mayor. Present all the members except Messrs Seibert & Truckess

On motion the reading of the minutes of the preceeding meeting was suspended

Mr Maguire presented the following ordinance

An Ordinance to suspend An Ordinance "entitled "An Ordinance in relation to lighting the City with gas" ordained the 11th of December 1854

Sec 1. Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Indianapolis "That the Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance in relation to lighting the City with gas" ordained and established the 11th day of December 1854, be and the same is hereby suspended until the 10th of May next

Sec 2. Be it further ordained, That the City will not be liable for any expenses incurred under Said Ordinance from the time to the period named in the first Section of this Ordinance

Sec 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage

Mr Graydon moved to postpone the consideration of the subject until the 10th May next

Mr Colley moved to amend said motion by saying "until next meeting" which amendment was accepted.

And said motion did not prevail by the following vote.
