a non-profit, membership organization for writers, artists, offset printers, cultural organizations, and anyone interested in book-making—was founded in 1976 as a resource center. Since that time, the Center has grown to over 1200 members. The Center offers over 35 workshops in poetry, fiction, playwriting, non-fiction prose, hands-on offset printing, phototypesetting, graphic design, and experimental book-making to over 900 students a year.

The Center also sponsors poetry and fiction readings by local authors as well as such nationally known authors as Howard Nemerov, Philip Levine, John Gardner and D.M. Thomas. In the Center's book gallery, member authors, artists, and small press publishers display and sell their books, broadsides, and paper sculptures.

The Center also helps other cultural institutions, artists, and writers with the design, typesetting, and printing of books, brochures, posters, newsletters, and experimental pieces.
